We specialise in the magnificent yet comparatively little-known region of the Peloponnese, home to illustrious Classical, Byzantine, Ottoman and Venetian sites, including famed Ancient Olympia, Mycenae, Mystras, Sparta and Nemea, to locations steeped in mythology and history as well as the fascinating natural monuments of mountain lakes, forbidding peaks, friendly hills, breath-taking grottoes, wild promontories and gently-rolling vineyard country, all of which beckon the traveller in an ever-changing mosaic of sights, scents, sounds and colours.

All our tours and programmes are meticulously researched and focus on specific themes which touch upon both famous as well as lesser known - yet equally thrilling - characteristics of Greece in general and the Peloponnese in particular. The groups typically range from eight to sixteen people in size and the tours are conducted round the year with myself as the tour-leader in some of the programmes and are all supported and escorted by our hand-picked specialist guides.

We offer both small-group tours as well as self-drive and FIT programmes for families and individual travellers.

GREECE is a treasure-trove, evoking millennia of myths, legends and feats of civilisation, history and nature. It is renowned internationally for its beaches, its gentle climate, its light yet hearty cuisine and its friendly and vibrant society.



shrine on the remote mountain-side, accept the invitation for a simple meal under the olive tree by the friendly elderly peasant couple. Be ready to toil on the rocky, lofty mountain range but also to wander on the thyme-covered, beckoning hillock. Wake up early so as not to miss the rising sun reflected on our sea, its waves and ripples shining back the light and playfully synthesising a zillion small dawns which will light your mind.

It is only then, through this mosaic of such simple yet rich experiences, that the Essence of Greece will slowly come out and welcome you. I have been travelling in Greece since my early teens and I am always touched and inspired, as if it was the first time, by the deep feeling of this country. I have tried to capture some of it on film, but what can be seen from the pictures only conveys a minuscule proportion of what can actually be experienced.

Heracles (Hercules) (9 days / 8 nights)

Four Labours of Hercules, Two Mythical Entrances to Hades (the Underworld) and Archaeological Treasures of the Peloponnese.

This original, exciting and enriching programme breaks new ground as it includes visits to the sites of four of Heracles's legendary twelve labours, two of the mythical entrances to Hades (the Underworld of the ancient Greeks) as well as to other prominent archaeological, historical and natural monuments in the Peloponnese, such as fabled Mycenae, the pyramid of Hellinikon, the Byzantine citadel of Mystras and the magnificent caves of Diros. Being in the Peloponnese we would not fail to include genuine and charismatic local food as well as delectable local wines.



Nine UNESCO World Heritage Sites in the Peloponnese and Southern Greece (11 days / 10 nights)

Greece is home to seventeen UNESCO World Heritage sites, of which more than half are in the Peloponnese and southern Greece. This thrilling and instructive programme will take us to the following illustrious examples of architecture, history and civilisation:

- The world-renowned theatre and Asclepium of Epidaurus
- The megathilic citadel of Tiryns, legendary birthplace of hero and demi-god Heracles

- The temple of Apollo Epicurius by Iktinos, designer of the Parthenon, perched on a remote mountain-top
- Olympia, cradle of the Olympic Games in 776 BC


The revived Nemean Games take place every four years at their very birthplace of Ancient Nemea in the Peloponnese.
